

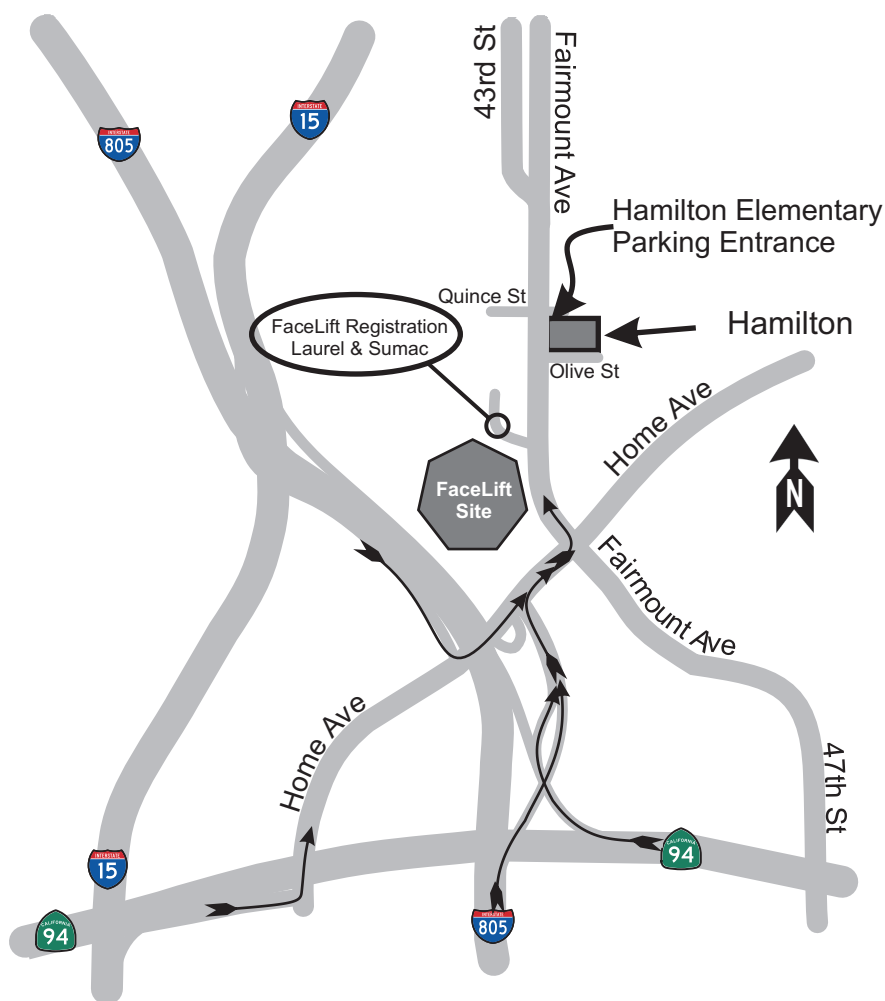

## How can you help?

- ⊕ Summer 2008 FaceLift is a NeighborWorks joint project between Community HousingWorks and volunteer groups within City Heights and San Diego to clean up the Hollywood Park Neighborhood area.
- ⊕ Ten to Twelve homes are to be painted and tons of trash will be hauled away from neighboring properties and canyons to dumpsters on site.
- ⊕ Summer 2008 FaceLift is generously sponsored by the City Heights Project Area Committee with Redevelopment Agency funds, Bank of America, State Farm Insurance, City National Bank, Price Charities and Councilmember Toni Atkins.

Whenever possible, please pre-sign your Volunteer Waiver. Bring to the Event Tent at Laurel and Sumac to register. The first 300 volunteers will receive a T-shirt. There is some parking in the Hollywood Park parking lot off of Sumac and Juniper.

If some individuals on your team can bring weed whackers or pick-ups to haul debris from your house assignment, have them come directly to

the FaceLift site at Laurel and Sumac. However, they must be responsible and keep track of their equipment.

Each volunteer under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult. Gloves, supplies and tools are provided. Bring your own work gloves if you wish. Wear sunscreen, a hat, paint clothes and paint shoes.

Team leaders will be provided with a profile on their homeowner and their home assignment ahead of time. Each house will have an experienced house captain assigned to them. Paint and equipment can be found at each house.
